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

















Public Programming

Yasmeen Siddiqui and Shahzia Sikander (November 5)

Eliza Swann with Genevieve De Leon (Dec 6) Artist Shahzia Sikander, Director/Founder of Minerva Projects Yasmeen Siddiqui, and UrbanGlass Curator At Large Alpesh Kantilal Patel discuss *The Glass Mosque*, a collaboration among Sikander, composer Vijay Iyer, poet Bhanu Kapil and author Fred Moten, The four are equal partners in this three-year creative project begun in 2022. *The Glass Mosque* will be realized as a book, produced by Siddiqui, and perhaps an artwork.

The Vessel and the Void - An Introduction to Scrying (1 hr 20 minutes)

There are few exercises that can get us into the oracular state as deeply as scrying - come learn a history and some techniques for practicing this ancient divination practice. Scrying comes from the Old English word descry meaning "to make out dimly" or "to reveal." Scrying is an auto-deepening trance practice traditionally achieved by staring into a smooth dark surface. During this session we'll learn about some tools and practice techniques for finding guidance and illumination through the art of staring into the void. All materials will be provided.
